Subject: Use of Club Event Equipment by Members

Priority 1 – Club use for event

Priority 2 – Use by club members for member activity, ie group camping at Fryeburg, etc. (no fee applied)

A “group” is defined as five or more members of CATS using the equipment together.

Priority 3 – Use by club member(s) for personal use, (usage fee applies)

Availability Limitations – CATS may restrict availability of equipment prior to a CATS event (generally one full week prior) to ensure the equipment is ready for use and in suitable condition. This request form must be approved by the Club President prior to the equipment being picked up for use.

(Note: Ring agility equipment, i.e., jumps tunnels, contact obstacles, cones, etc is the responsibility of the Equipment Committee and it is not available for rent or use other than at CATS sanctioned trials, matches, show&gos, demos and seminars due to liability and insurance concerns.)

All equipment must be promptly returned clean, dry and ready for use. Repair or replacement due to damage or unusual wear is the responsibility of the CATS' member. The CATS President must be promptly advised of any damage or problems with club equipment.
