CLASS DESCRIPTION

DISTANCE on Saturday. Confidence is a key component in getting distance and drive from your partner so they will happily move away from you to sequences or obstacles at a distance. Also work on how to find the right spot to handle your dog from when sending them out. Debi is a master at distance and helping handlers achieve this. It is something that is needed in all venues so come join the fun.

SETTING THE LINE on Sunday. Setting the line puts emphasis on what you see and do before the dog lands so that you are setting the path for the next obstacle. It is one of the most important things you can do to help your dog around the course with speed and confidence.
